Prominent murmur of insects with light wind, insects often close and featured pollinators. Birdsongs spacious, sometimes prominent. Droning of grouse in very far background sounds similar to distant conversation. Birds include Nashville Warbler, Spotted Towhee, Western Tanager, Wilson's Warbler, Red-winged Blackbird, White-throated Swift, Brown-headed Cowbird. Loop.

Wind in forest with active birds including Pacific Wren, American Robin, Varied Thrush. Douglas' Squirrel present. Loop.

Soft wind in forest with diverse birds and prominent woodpecker drumming near and far. Bird close at 1:26, 3:08 and later. Hummingbird J-arch 4:53 and again at 5:38. Birds present are Sooty Grouse, American Robin, Pacific Wren, Swainson's Thrush, Wilson's Warbler, Pileated Woodpecker, Red Crossbill, Black-throated Gray Warbler, Rufous Hummingbird, Pine Siskin. Douglas's Squirrel present. Loop.
